Camperships-Budget

Presbytery Council approved the use of \$2,000 from the operating reserves to fund camperships for 2008. Each child/youth can apply for one \$25 scholarship to a Dwight Mission summer camp opportunity and one \$25 to a Presbyterian-related camp/conference/retreat. Churches may request camperships by filling out a voucher (found at www.cimarronpresbytery.org under "resources"). Be sure to include the camper's name and which camp/retreat/conference they are attending. Vouchers may be sent to the Cimarron Presbytery treasurer, John McNeese.

Cimarron Youth Council

The Youth Council has now met twice and is beginning plans for a presbytery-wide fall retreat for youth 6th-12th grades (possibly at Stillwater in October). Presbytery Council approved the use of \$2,000 from the operating reserves to help fund the fall retreat.
